Buying Buckwheat Seed

If you would like to contract with us, the following standards will apply:

- Contract will be completed at pick up, and full payment is required at that time.
- The Birkett Mills is proud to offer 100% full production contracts.
- Seed is available on a first come, first served basis starting May 2, 2022, at The Birkett Mills' Transloading Facility located at 224 North Avenue, Penn Yan, NY. Pickup is available Monday through Friday, 8am until 3pm, or on weekends by appointment (315-536-3311).
- Contracts typically go quickly; we recommend calling to reserve your seed in advance.
- Seed can only be reserved for a maximum of 14 days. If the seed is not picked up within two weeks from the time of your call, the seed may be sold to others. All seed purchased in advance must be taken in full; no partial lot of seed will be held or stored.

Delivering Buckwheat Grain After Harvest

All buckwheat harvested this season will be received at our Hamilton Street Facility located at 118 Hamilton Street, Penn Yan, NY through October 31, 2022. Receiving hours are Monday-Friday from 7:30am-3pm or by appointment.

After October 31, please call 315-536-4112 to make an appointment.

Organic Requirements

If you're certified organic grower, simply fill out a Certified Organic Contract when picking up seed. A few important things to remember:

- **Organic growers must comply with Canadian Organic Regulations (COR).**
- Be sure to check with your certifying agency on what is required to be COR certified *prior* to planting. This continues to be an emphasis for organic certifying agencies.
- The Birkett Mills cannot assist with the organic certification of your property, contact your local extension agent if you'd like to get certified

2022 Conventional Buckwheat Production Contract

We, The Birkett Mills, agree to purchase from you, the grower, all conventional 2021 crop buckwheat grain grown from seed purchased from us under this contract for \$32 per cwt. delivered to Penn Yan, NY.

The following specifications, conditions, and procedures are to apply:

1. The Birkett Mills will lease seed, and grower (lessee) must plant only buckwheat seed purchased from The Birkett Mills.
2. The Birkett Mills will sell one (1) bag of seed per acre contracted and agrees to purchase the production harvested by the grower.
3. All buckwheat grain delivered to The Birkett Mills must comply with The Birkett Mills' "Official Standards for Buckwheat & Receiving" document. Additionally, the following specifications apply:
 - **Grade** - Cool, sweet, milling quality buckwheat grown from buckwheat seed provided by The Birkett Mills.
 - **Conditioning** – The Birkett Mills clean destination, outturn weight, grade, and moisture will apply. Buckwheat will be subject to dockage discount after cleaning of 1% of the total weight for each ½% of moisture over 15% and a test weight discount of 1% for each ½% under 46 pounds per bushel.
 - **Foreign Material** – Glutinous Grains (Wheat/Rye/Barley) and/or Soy is limited to one whole/broken kernel per pound (450 grams) **MAXIMUM**. Any findings above one kernel per pound will result in rejection of entire shipment due to FDA Allergen laws.
4. Delivery to be made to Penn Yan, NY by March 31, 2023, unless other arrangements are made.
5. Contracts must be completed at the time seed is purchased. The Birkett Mills will contract on a total production basis, all the 2022 buckwheat crop which grower (seller) harvest from seed purchased from The Birkett Mills. Contracts must be filled out in the name of the person selling. The grower signing below agrees to not convey, share, or transfer to any place or person buckwheat seed purchased or grain harvested from this seed to anyone other than The Birkett Mills or its authorized affiliates.
6. Settlement – The Birkett Mills will process and mail settlements within 14 days from the date that the last load of grain is received.
